

## Patient Preparation and Information

Test	Patient Preparation	Estimated Time in Nuclear Medicine			
Bone Scan	No preparation	20 - 30 minutes- 1 <sup>st</sup> visit  1 <sup>st</sup> appointment for injection then you may leave the hospital 30 - 90 minutes- 2 <sup>nd</sup> visit  Return 2 to 3 hours later			
Cardiac Stress Testing	No caffeine for 48 hours prior to your appointment: No tea or coffee, even decaffeinated, colas or chocolate. This includes medications which include caffeine, such as Tylenol 1's and 3's.  Nothing to eat 6 hours prior to the appointment. (sips of water ok)  Diabetics please call for modified diet.  Please bring a list of your medications.	Test takes up to 6 hours in total.  There will be a 1 - 2 hour break halfway through the test and you may eat 1 piece of fruit (i.e. banana, apple, etc.) and drink water or juice at this time.			
MUGA	No preparation	Takes approximately 1 hour			
Gallium	No Preparation - unless told otherwise	Specific Site: 15 mins Day 1 Injection only 30 - 45 mins Day 3 (48hrs post injection) - Scan Up to 20 mins Day 4 (72hrs post injection) - Scan Whole Body: 15 mins Day 1 Injection only 3 hours Day 3 or 4 - Scan			
Thyroid	Patient needs to be OFF Thyroxine X 3 weeks and PTU X 1 week	Approximately 45 minutes			
Biliary Scan (HIDA)	Nothing to eat or drink after midnight	Approximately 1 ½ - 4 ½ hours			
Lung	No preparation	Approximately 1 - 1 ½ hours			
Parathyroid	No preparation	1 hour scan, then approximately 1-2 hour wait, then 1½ hour scan			
Gastric Emptying	Nothing to eat or drink after midnight	Approximately 2 hours			
Meckel's Scan	Nothing to eat or drink after midnight	Approximately 1 hour			
Salivary	No preparation	Approximately 45 minutes			
Renal Function	Drink 1 litre of water an hour prior to your appointment	Approximately 30 minutes - 1 hour
